2020 Sauvignon Blanc

From the time Starmont first appeared on a label in 1989, the name has been recognized for classically styled varietal wines that are expressive and approachable. Now 30 years later, led by Winemaker Jeff Crawford Starmont is producing some of their best wines ever as part of the Merryvale Family of Wines. Focused on sustainability and making the highest quality wines, the Stanly Ranch Estate Vineyard has been Napa Green Certified since 2007.

Winemaking

Our goal for Starmont Sauvignon Blanc is complexity on the nose with nice fresh notes (lime leaf and lemongrass), citrus notes (key lime), floral notes (citrus blossom), and tropical notes (guava, lychee, pineapple), and the 2020 vintage is no exception.

Wine Notes

Sourced from both Sonoma and Napa Counties in California's North Coast wine region, each component contributes its own distinct expression to the final blend. Fermentation was done in stainless steel tanks followed by only a few months aging in neutral oak barrels. You will find lemongrass, guava and honeydew melon on the nose, and the wine's round entry on the palate is followed by a bright freshness with a lingering finish. This wine can be enjoyed either on its own or with food, and will continue to develop nicely for 2+ years from vintage.
